



"Thank You" Cards

From "Teachers Rock!", Season 4, Episode 6

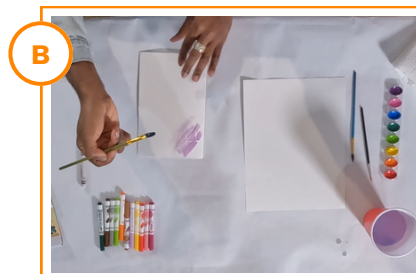


Supplies

- One Sheet of Paper
- A Napkin
- Multicolored Watercolor Paints
- Paintbrushes
- Water in a Plastic Cup
- One White Crayon

Steps

1. Fold the sheet of print paper in half
2. On one side of the paper, write "Thank You" with the white crayon.
3. Grab a paintbrush, dip in the water, then pick a color and paint over the "Th" in "Thank You".
4. Dip the paintbrush in the water again and choose another color to paint over the "an" in "Thank You".
4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 until the entire phrase is covered in paint.
5. Give the card to someone you really appreciate for being a teacher to you!
